- 1) Passes all (unit) tests
- 2) Expresses all ideas we need to express Self-documenting
 - · 1 idea per method / class
 - · Names of variables / methods / classes reveal intent
 - · Methods & classes are understandable from their public interface
- 3) Has no superfluous parts
 - · Minimal methods / classes / modules
 - · Only add what you need right now ("You Ain't Gonna Need It")
- 4) Duplicates no concept, behavior or configuration
